Absolutely no entries will be accepted Saturday, August 6. NO entries will be changed after Friday 7:00 p.m., August 5.** Articles will be accepted Thursday, August 4, 3:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m., Friday, August 5, Noon - 7:00 p.m. and Saturday, August 6, 8:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. **Articles entered must be in place for judging by 10:00 a.m. Saturday, August 6 and may not be removed until the hours of 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Saturday, August 13.** All premium checks must be picked up Saturday, August 13, 9:00 a.m.-Noon. No premium checks will be mailed unless a self-addressed stamped envelope is provided. Pay special attention to quantities designated.
