Overnight races exceeding 9 entries race according to USTA Rule #13, Section 3a or 3b (Eliminations 60%-Final 40%).

Fair Association reserves the right to require 5 entries or event will be canceled. Fair Association reserves the right to go one heat of each overnight if conditions justify.

Big Ten will race colts and fillies separately when possible.

**Participants in the Mid-Western Amateur Driving Championship must race horses that fit the following conditions: Horses three years old and up in 2005 that were non-winners of \$20,000 in 2004 and non-winners of \$100,000 Lifetime. Nominated drivers need to obtain their own horse to drive. Horses do not need to be owned by driver. The Effingham County Fair Association does not provide driver accident insurance.

The Illinois Department of Agriculture has determined that no horse racing at the Illinois County Fairs will be permitted to start more than two times during a three-day consecutive period, and further that no horse will be permitted to start more than three times during seven consecutive days. A "start" is to be considered each individual heat that a horse races. This policy will apply to Stakes races as well as Overnight races and aged horses as well as two- and three-year-olds.

If the entry is in violation of the above-stated policy, the entry must be denied and the horse must not be allowed to race. The Bureau of County Fairs and Horse Racing will keep a record of horses racing at the Illinois County Fairs.
