## GLEN MATHIAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM PROGRAM OUTLINE

1. After the evening event, we draw three \$100 winners. Winners must be present to win.
2. The three winners will nominate a school to qualify for the Fair Scholarship.
3. On the night of the fair board annual meeting, we will have a drawing of the schools represented.
4. Two schools are then drawn to receive a \$500 scholarship.
5. IGA, McDonalds, Lehur Ideal Rides, and Fair Board presents scholarship to winning schools
6. In March or April of 2019, students from winning schools will submit application for this scholarship.
7. Application will include writing a 200 word essay on "WHY IS AGRICULTURE IMPORTANT TO EFFINGHAM COUNTY." Judging will also be based on school activities and fair involvement.
8. Scholarship then awarded to selected student at a time selected by the school.
